After being lucky enough to purchase our part of own land in luwero where we will build our own schools that will encompass, nursery, Primary, secondary and further construction of technical institute that will help our Malezi Children to acquire hands on skills.

Our future aim is to build a school for vulnerable children that will provide more access to school hence creating a lasting smile on the faces of the vulnerable children. In order to create safety of the children, we have a dream of building Malezi village, where all the children will be staying and attending school at the same time.

What we do

MALEZI SNILES UGANDA is a registered international non-governmental organization (NGO) based in Kampala as our office, Operating in luwero district. Our main is to reach out to the vulnerable children, Youth, Elderly, single mothers, and a girl Child, and facilitate lasting smiles in the lives. This is achieved by providing support through education, health and livelihood programs as well as the children with special needs.

Our work remains focused on the most vulnerable living in Luwero and we continue to maintain the personal community involvement that has become the trademark of MSU. The unique selection/assessment process for children to join our programs ensures we continue to select those children who are the poorest of the poor and at the lowest levels of the community. Previous year we have been feeding and supported approximately 100 children, 10 single Mothers and 20 elderly people in the community through our different programs. Currently we fully support 32 vulnerable children through child sponsorship.

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Our Achievements

Besides, the land we brought for the organization, we have managed to rise some of the funds that have helped to pay school fees for 32 vulnerable children. With our increase in scope and impact, the move coincided with registration of our own organization (NGO) .

We continued to consolidate our work on improving the lives of those living vulnerable children, single mothers and a girl. Because of the support we have got some individuals, that's the reason why 32 vulnerable children are going to school, receiving two warm meals per day and basic health care even when we haven't completed the required amount.

More women have been socio-economically empowered through our sewing programs and more young people have been supported to receive basic skills in that perceptive. We have also reached out more widely to the whole community through our health club and regular trainings.



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Other Activities

The year 2021 has been long and challenging but rewarding too, and we are proud of our progress thus far. At MSU, we are growing bigger and better. We are gradually making considerable strides in making our dreams of ensuring that young people (children) achieve their education, youths are supported with vocational skills, and older people are helped accordingly as our dream comes true.

From a team of over five vibrant, passionate, resilient, and skilled volunteers, MSU would like to appreciate the efforts and support of the community leaders, project beneficiaries, our donors, and everyone within our esteemed networks that enabled us to build trust, confidence as well as put a beautiful smile on the faces of young vulnerable children and communities in Uganda during the COVID-19 pandemic. REPORT FOR MSU CHILDREN'S EDUCATION PROGRAM TERM ONE



Our education program has continued to expand in size. With now 32 children fully under malezi smiles Uganda child sponsorship. Our child sponsorship program included 32 children. That is 14 in nurseries, 17 in primary and one in secondary. In addition, we have continued to support many children with scholastic materials close to 20 in number but are not on our sponsorship program .

Through our generous donors' support, MSU managed to put a lasting smile on the faces of 32 vulnerable children on fully sponsorship program and giving others scholastic materials. It is such a great achievement for the vulnerable children in Uganda. As we continued to make a meaning impact in the community, celebrating Christ Jesus, touching those around us with love of Jesus Christ, bringing healing to the cities and nations.

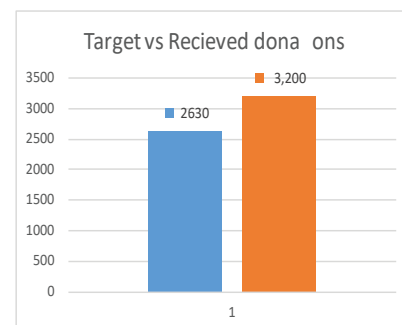

The expenditure is converted into dollars. On school fees we only paid for 19 children out of 32 we have under our program. However, we managed to buy all the scholastic materials needed by the school, pay all the feeding fee for 32 children.

Our target was \$ 3200 to completely buy all the scholastic materials, pay school fees, pay feeding fee and buy other requirements for the school. However, we only managed to get \$2630. Meaning we have a debit of \$ 570 to complete the school payment for all the vulnerable children.

Finacial Report for child Sponsorship

The target funding was \$3200 for 32 vulnerable children, including scholastic materials, school fees , developement fee, feeding fee and other items that a required by the school.

Generous Donors

Brick Making Project

We had made our bricks for building on the land we brought but since we lacked funds to help us run the Child sponership program, we agreed as the team to seel the bricks inorder to meetthe educational need of thevulnerable children. The project managed to give us \$800 . Glory be to God.



Risk Assessment

Financial Risks

Malezi Smiles Uganda failure to raise the required total amount for specific project commitments. This can put at risk the continued functioning of the organization plus its impact in the community.

Failure to raise the funds for Child Sponsorship or any project can put at risk the future of the vulnerable children thus resulting into distrust in the community and the government which might make our organization to be disqualified .

Malezi Smiles Uganda-specific risks

Malezi Smiles Uganda might be deprived of critical local licenses if it violated laws and guidelines for NGOs.

Failure to fully implement our projects, vulnerable children might join peer organizations because of the idleness.

Malezi Smiles could lose the trust of community, important stakeholders in projects: village citizens, village chiefs, teaching staff at schools, parents, collaborators, provincial authorities, donors, and many more if we don't implement fully the targeted projects.



Challenges

- Increased prices for most items due to the late purchase i.e. all the scholastic materials. Some items that cost less during the period we purchased scholastic materials for children doubled.
- Many vulnerable children were left out of the program because of limitation in our funds, and also the willingness of the donors to support more children.
- Financial constraints due to limited funds; some children's school fees were not paid and we don't when they will be paid.

Suggestion

- Early purchase of children's scholastic materials to avoid hiked prices during the season.
- Implementation of partner's program to sponsor many vulnerable children.
- More funds are required to make thorough preparations and adding more of the vulnerable children on the program.

Conclusion

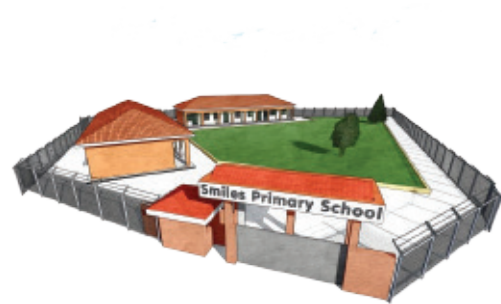
